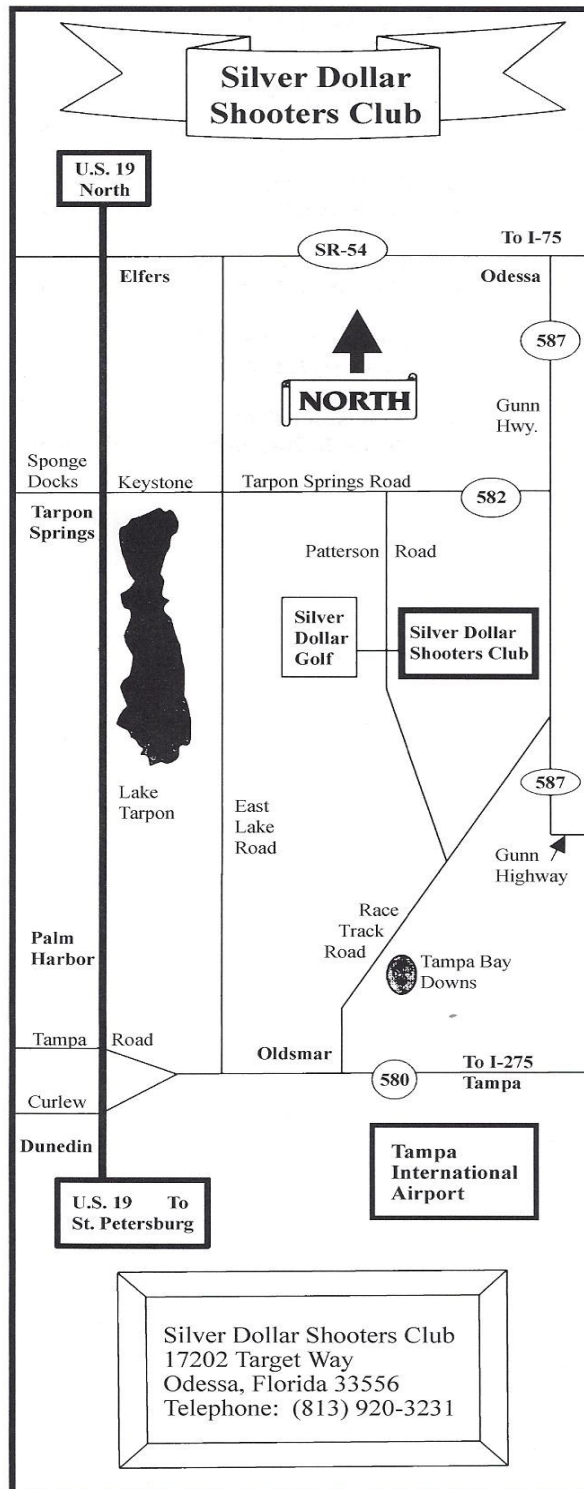

Attire and Fees

Entry Fee \$95.00. All participants must wear appropriate hearing and eye protection. No open toe shoes, sandals or flip flops allowed while participating in the event.

Flash Targets and Silent Auction

Shoot at and break a "FLASH" target to automatically win a box of ammo. Silent auction ends 30 minutes after the conclusion of shooting.

Scoring and Rules

50 handicap targets set to Amateur Trap Shooting Association specifications. ATA yardages will be used for all participants except...NOVICE CHAIRSHOOTERS will shoot at 16 yard line...all other shooters without an ATA number will shoot at 24 yard line. Entrants must follow ATA protocol.



Liability Release & PVA Trap Shoot Circuit Rules

All competitors will be required to sign a "waiver and release of liability upon check-in at the Gun Club, and before being allowed to compete. Copies of the PVA National Trap Shoot Circuit's modifications to standard ATA rules will be available at the gun club and are also available for viewing online at www.pva.org/shooting sports.

Florida Gulf Coast reserves the right to change or modify this program, and reject any entry deemed detrimental to the shoot. Decisions by shoot officials are final. Lewis Class System will apply. All ammunition used in the competition must be ATA legal ammunition. Absolutely no reloaded ammunition may be used for competition. Any participant found using reloaded ammunition will forfeit entry.
